What makes your testimony significant?

1 Corinthians 1:26...think of what you were when you were called.

Your testimony isn't about you and what you've done; it's about Christ and what he's done.

- And it's about how what Christ has done changes us.

Philippians 4:11-13 Paul learned to be content because he truly was content.

We must learn to be content know Jesus, to testify what Jesus did, is doing, and continues to do.

Your testimony is significant when you can recount how you survive through the good and the bad.

Romans 1:16-17 I am not ashamed of the gospel – the power of righteousness from first to last

The word of their testimony

Revelation 12:17; 17:6; 19:10; 20:4

- Their testimony is not *their* testimony; it is the testimony of Jesus.

Revelation 22:16 “I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star.”

- Jesus' identity is the testimony.

Their testimony was significant because they were willing to die for what they believed in.

Every day we find ourselves in circumstances where we must choose to die to the thoughts and attitudes and worldviews that tempt us to rely on our own strength, to **not** be content in any and every situation, to **not** believe that we can do everything through him who gives us strength.
