Acts 15:16-17 (NKJ)

David’s tabernacle was the pattern for worship in the New Testament church.

“[Hezekiah] did what was right in the eyes of
the Lord, just as his father David had done.”

2 Chronicles 29:2 (NIV)

2 Chronicles 29:3 – Hezekiah’s first priority
was to restore David’s tabernacle
and focus on worshipping the Lord.

2 Chronicles 29:11 (NIV) “For the Lord has CHOSEN you to...”

1. To stand before Him
2. To serve Him
3. To minister to Him
4. To burn incense (*Want to know how this relates to you today? See Psalm 141:2*)

Worship is expressed not in song but in obedience.
